Online TIF Requirements

The new online reporting system will allow you to download pre-populated 2004 TIF reports in Excel format onto your computer. The TIF reports then can be completed at your own pace and submitted by the August 1, 2005, deadline.

The 2004 TIF Excel spreadsheets are supported by the following programs (in order for your TIF reports to successfully download onto your computer): Microsoft Excel 97, 2000, XP, or 2003 version.
