WHEREAS, a provision was included in the State Government Finance Bill House File 1481 (Article 2, Section 3) and is as follows:

"A county, town, school district, or statutory or home rule charter city may file a written resolution with the State Auditor objecting to a state mandate or making recommendations for reforming a state mandate. The State Auditor must list on the State Auditor's website a list of all state mandates cited in a resolution under this section, and the name of the unit of local government citing the mandate", and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Indian tribes are considered sovereign nations and tribal courts exercise exclusive jurisdiction over their tribal members, and

WHEREAS, MS 260.751 to 260.835 (the Minnesota Indian Family Preservation Act) states that Minnesota counties are responsible for all costs associated with placements and services for Indian children within their county as determined by tribal courts,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Aitkin County does hereby request that state dollars be used to cover costs for these services.
