WHEREAS, purchases of goods and services made by Carlton County, and other local units of government, have been subject to a 6.5% sales tax as imposed by the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, this imposition of a 6.5% sales tax only serves to increase the costs to counties and other local units of government and thus increasing the burden upon the taxpayers.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Carlton County Board of Commissioners does hereby request that legislation be changed and that counties and other local units of government not be subjected to the 6.5% sales tax as imposed by the State of Minnesota.
