**Resolution No. 1:06**

**WHEREAS**, Local governments should retain authority over the decision based on the number of voters; and

**WHEREAS**, Local governments should be able to make the decision about what is the most cost effective process for their township; and


**WHEREAS**, the HAVA grant covers the initial cost of the machine but the cost of training, programming and testing will become the responsibility of the townships; and

**WHEREAS**, Mandating electronic machines for local government elections puts an undue hardship on township budgets.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by unanimous vote of the Daggett Brook Town Board to support that electronic voting at the March township elections be optional.
