WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute 6.79 allows local governments to submit to the State Auditor proposed reforms to state mandates, and

WHEREAS, the Fillmore County Board of Commissioners supports mandate reform and strongly recommends that the Minnesota Legislature to give serious consideration to proposals made by local units of government, and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute 3.98 requires a fiscal note be prepared at the request of the Chair of the standing committee to which the bill has been referred, and

WHEREAS, The implementation of JOBZ cost MN Counties Computer Cooperative nearly \$200,000 in software updates; and

WHEREAS, JOBZ may be used in Fillmore County in the future, but it has not been used to date; and

WHEREAS, Similar software upgrade costs are incurred each time there is a legislative change to the property tax system; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That data gathered to prepare fiscal notes include should include costs for software to implement the tax law changes.

LET IT FURTHER BE RESOLVED That legislation with high fiscal impacts be phased in or funding accompany the legislation to mitigate the financial impact.
