WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute 6.79 allows local governments to submit to the State Auditor proposed reforms to state mandates, and

WHEREAS, the Fillmore County Board of Commissioners supports mandate reform and strongly recommends that the Minnesota Legislator to give serious consideration to proposals made by local units of government, and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes 297A.61, 297A.62, and 297A.63 requires that local governments pay state sales and use taxes, and

WHEREAS, Sales tax in Fillmore County cost taxpayers an estimated \$39,410 in 2004, and

WHEREAS, Sales tax in Fillmore County cost taxpayers an estimated \$57,143 in 2005, and

WHEREAS, Sales and use tax on county purchases results in double taxation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fillmore County Board of Commissioners hereby unanimously supports legislation to re-instate sales and use tax exemptions on local units of government.
