A RESOLUTION FOR POSTING ON STATE AUDITOR'S WEBSITE PERTAINING TO MANDATE  
REFORM INITIATIVE.

Whereas the Federal Government passed the Help America Vote Act (HAVA) in 2002 to accommodate handicapped voters in Federal elections; and

Whereas in 2004 the Minnesota Legislature extended the HAVA requirements to state and local elections; and

Whereas it would be highly illogical for Fortier Township to use electronic voting machines for the March Township elections, due to high programming costs and other considerations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the town board of Fortier Township, Yellow Medicine County, Minnesota does not support the HAVA requirement that every polling precinct in Minnesota be required to use electronic voting equipment as proposed in House File 1703;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the town board of Fortier Township, Yellow Medicine County, Minnesota supports the concept that all Minnesota townships be exempt from HAVA requirements for the March township elections indefinitely.
