These sections address Day Treatment programming for children requiring that clinical supervision be more than 50% of the time on premises and that the services be provided in a minimum 3 hour block.

The supervision requirement is not practical when programming takes place in school buildings at different locations. The 3 hour block is too rigid especially as children transition back into "mainstream" classes and there are conflicting schedules. There are children whose condition is fragile who are not able to remain in a group setting for that length of time.

**Program provisions need to provide flexibility for varying numbers of students, differing needs, and school schedules.**
