
WHEREAS, the Isanti County Board of Commissioners supports the concept of mandate reform and urges the Minnesota Legislature to give serious consideration to all proposals made by Cities, Townships and Counties,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, the Isanti County Board of Commissioners adopts the following as mandates that should be strongly considered for elimination or changes to be made and directs the County Coordinator to submit this listing to the State Auditor:

Mandate Relief Requested	Statutory Citation	Comments
Eliminate or Equalize maintenance of Effort Requirement for State Chemical Dependency Grant (CCDTF)	254B.02	Under the state's Consolidated Chemical Dependency Treatment Fund, some counties pay over 60% of chemical dependency treatment costs while others pay as little as 15% under current maintenance of effort (MOE) requirements. The state legislature should gradually narrow this disparity with a goal of ultimately making the MOE a uniform for all counties.
