

WHEREAS, a provision was included in the State Government Finance Bill House File 1481 (Article 2, Section 3) and is as follows:

“A county, town, school district, or statutory or home rule charter city may file a written resolution with the State Auditor objecting to a state mandate or making recommendations for reforming a state mandate. The State Auditor must list on the State Auditor’s website a list of all state mandates cited in a resolution under this section, and name the unit of local government citing the mandate”, and

WHEREAS, MS 256B.83, requires counties to invest any increase in revenue into expanded mental health services and

WHEREAS, counties are precluded from investing increased revenues in inpatient and residential treatment services or mandated service areas receiving federal funding cuts

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Pine County does hereby request that the additional revenue be left to the county to allocate or the mandate specifying the use of the revenue be eliminated.

Motion by Commissioner Anderson to approve and adopt Resolutions in support of State mandates on Counties which should be rescinded or modified, and to request that the State Auditor post said Resolutions for the State Legislature to consider being rescinded or modifying as authorized under State legislation. 
