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Zoning deadlines	M.S. 15.99	State law currently requires cities to maintain sufficient staffing to meet 60-day deadlines for approving zoning applications. 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State zoning standards	M.S. 463.365	Local zoning decisions for manufactured homes, group homes, earth-sheltered homes etc., are limited by the state.
