

Market Value Homestead Credit		Each year since 2003, the State has not reimbursed cities for the Market Value Homestead Credit. To date, Plymouth has lost more than \$2 million in promised reimbursements from the state. In order to remove unpredictability from budgeting and to improve transparency, the City also encourages the state to provide Market Value Homestead Credit directly to homeowners, rather than administering the program through the cities. The City does not oppose the intent of the mandate, but rather objects if it is unfunded or underfunded.
