

Absentee ballots for overseas voters	M.S. 203B.16-17	Overseas voters may submit absentee ballot applications by fax or email (if Secretary of State determines that security concerns have been addressed) as well as in writing, meaning that local election administrator must set up a process for receiving and processing fax and email absentee applications and mailing out ballots, return envelopes, and postage to voters outside the U.S. The City does not oppose the intent of the mandate, but rather objects if it is unfunded or underfunded.
Absentee ballots for subsequent elections	M.S. 203B.16-17	Local election administrators must automatically arrange to mail out absentee ballots for any general or special election for the remainder of the calendar year to overseas voters who previously applied for an absentee ballot for the primary that year. The City does not oppose the intent of the mandate, but rather objects if it is unfunded or underfunded.
