The use and nature of these properties frequently increase city costs (police, fire, road maintenance, street lighting, etc.)</p> <p>Examples include: state institutions such as universities, hospitals, corrections facilities, and other state-owned properties. The City does not oppose the intent of the mandate, but rather objects if it is unfunded or underfunded.</p>
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
