



RESOLUTION No. 2026-54

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY OF NOWTHEN'S PARTICIPATION IN THE STATE COUNCIL ON LOCAL RESULTS AND INNOVATION – PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, In 2010, the Minnesota Legislature created the Council on Local Results and Innovation; and,

WHEREAS, The Council on Local Results and Innovation developed a standard set of performance measures that will aid residents, taxpayers, and state and local elected officials in determining the efficacy of counties in providing services and measure residents' opinion of those services; and,

WHEREAS, Benefits to the City of Participating in the Minnesota Council on Local Results and Innovation's comprehensive performance measurement program are outlined in MS 6.91 and include eligibility for reimbursement as set by state statute; and,

WHEREAS, Any City participating in the comprehensive performance measurement program is also exempt from levy limits for taxes, if levy limits are in effect; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Nowthen has adopted and implemented at least 10 of the performance measures, as developed by the Council on Local Results and Innovation, and a system to use this information to help plan, budget, manage, and evaluate programs and processes for optimal future outcomes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOWTHEN

1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein.
2. The City of Nowthen will continue to report the results of the performance measures to its citizens by the end of the year through publication, direct mailing, posting on the city website, or through a public hearing at which the budget and levy will be discussed and public input allowed.
3. The City of Nowthen will submit to the Office of the State Auditor the actual results of the performance measures adopted by the City by the due date of July 1, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOWTHEN,

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing resolution was proposed by Mayor Hybben and was duly seconded by Council Member Rainville and upon vote being taken thereon, the following voted in favor via roll call: 5 ayes, motion carried.

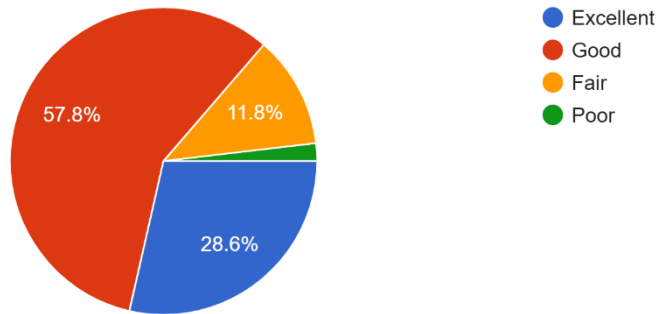

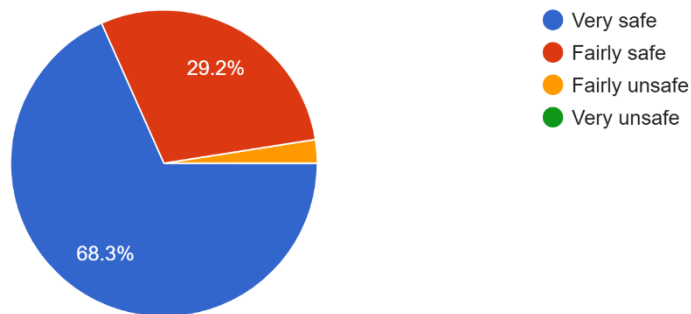

Rate the feeling of safety in the City of Nowthen.

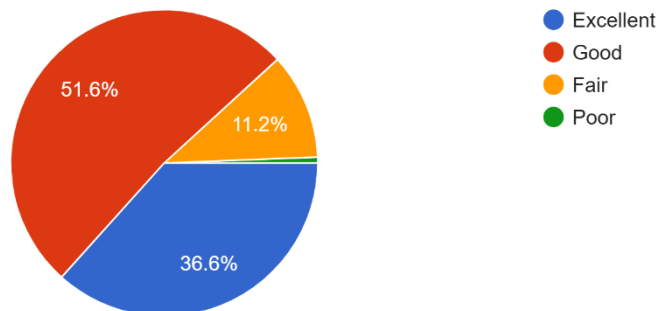

Rate the quality of fire protection services in the City of Nowthen.

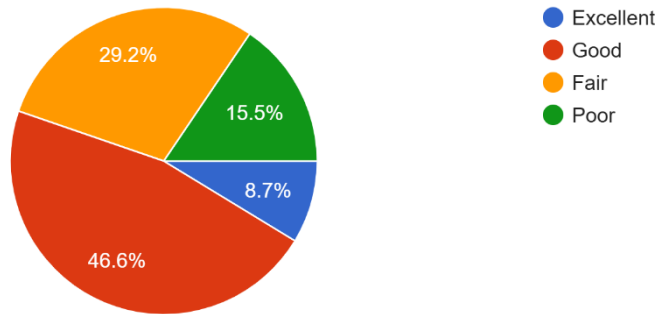

Rate the road conditions in the City of Nowthen.

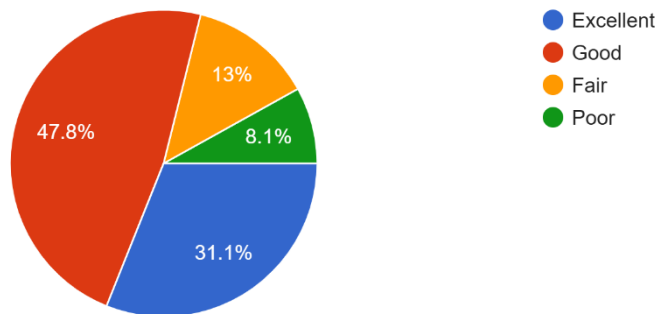
