1. Deadline: Forfeiture Reporting

March 20th is the deadline for law enforcement agencies to report final disposition of property seized subject to forfeiture for the month of February. To report final disposition of forfeitures, please go to:

4. Avoiding Pitfalls: Data Practices

Local governments must comply with the Minnesota Data Practices Act. Towns, however, are generally exempt – only towns in the metropolitan area with urban powers must comply with the Data Practices Act.
