## REPORT ON MINNESOTA LEGAL COMPLIANCE

Ramsey/Washington County Resource  
Recovery Project Board

We have audited the financial statements of the governmental activities and the General Fund of the Ramsey/Washington County Resource Recovery Project Board as of and for the year ended December 31, 2009, which collectively comprise the Ramsey/Washington County Resource Recovery Project's basic financial statements. We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the provisions of the *Minnesota Legal Compliance Audit Guide for Local Government*, promulgated by the State Auditor pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 6.65. Accordingly, the audit included such tests of the accounting records and such other auditing procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances.

The *Minnesota Legal Compliance Audit Guide for Local Government* contains six categories of compliance to be tested: contracting and bidding, deposits and investments, conflicts of interest, public indebtedness, claims and disbursements, and miscellaneous provisions. Our study included all of the listed categories, except that we did not test for compliance in public indebtedness because there is no long-term debt outstanding.

The results of our tests indicate that, for the items tested, the Ramsey/Washington County Resource Recovery Project Board complied with the material terms and conditions of applicable legal provisions.
